School Updates 2022/04 (Secondary 2 Normal(A) & 2 Express)

1. Secondary 2 Parent-Teacher Meeting

The Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) will take place on **27 May 2022 (Friday)**. It will be held in the school hall. To facilitate the meeting with as many parents/guardians as possible, the PTM will be held from **8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.**. Hence, there will be no lessons conducted that day. **We strongly encourage both parents/guardian to attend the PTM with your child/ward**, to ensure common understanding of your child's/ ward's progress and follow-up actions, moving forward.

You will receive a message from Parents Gateway app to book a 20-minute timeslot to meet your child's/ ward's Home Tutor. The booking will start from 11 to 19 May 2022. More information for the booking will be provided later. We seek your cooperation to adhere to the timeslot you have booked.

Your child/ward will receive his/her Semestral 1 report on 26 May 2022.

In the event you are unable to attend the PTM on 27 May, please contact your child's/ward's Home Tutor to arrange for a separate meeting during the first week of June, especially if your child's/ward's learning attitude and performance has not been satisfactory. We believe the timely sharing of information will help you in guiding your child/ward well in their revision during the June holidays.

2. Goal Setting Discussion

Your child/ward has set some academic and personal goals in Term 2 during Crest Time in school.

The objectives of engaging your child/ward in the goal setting process are:

1. To inculcate in Crestians the school's motto of "Pursue and Realise Challenges"
2. To instill in each Crestian the PRCS values:
